Scarborough's White Label semilon is 'released only from exceptional vintages' – though since 2000, the 2001 vintage is the only one to miss out on a release.

It's both immediately appealing and immediately impressive for its quality. It's got line and length, yet pulpy, waxy, fleshy mouthfeel. It's lemony and bright, has a slight spritz, and pierces beautifully through the finish. I could easily hook into this now, but in three or four years it should be at its absolute peak.
